
Due to the extreme drought conditions, Dobbin-Plantersville WSC will be implementing a "Stage I, Water Use Restriction". Our goal of the restriction is to achieve a voluntary 30% percent reduction in total water use, daily water demand, etc. During this stage I Restriction, customers are ask to voluntarily conserve water.

Voluntary Water Use Restrictions: Effectively Immediately!

- (a) Water customers are requested to voluntarily limit the irrigation of landscaped areas to Monday and Wednesdays for customers with account number ending in an even number (0,2 4,6,or 8), and Tuesdays and Thursdays for water customers with an account number ending in an odd number (1,3,5,7,or 9), and to irrigate landscapes only between the hours of midnight and 6:00 a.m. on designated watering days.
- (b) All operations of the Dobbin-Plantersville WSC shall adhere to water use restrictions prescribed for Stage 2 of the Plan.
- (c) Water customers are requested to practice water conservation and to minimize or discontinue water use for non-essential purposes.

Although this rationing alert is voluntarily at this time, please understand that the wells are pumping at capacity and to avoid any major outages we are asking for your cooperation in this voluntary restriction plan.
